

FAQ ABOUT REGIONAL ATHLETICS IN THE FAR NORTHEAST

What is the Regional Athletic Program?

A program designed to allow all students who passionate about sports to competitively participate together with other student athletes from the FNE. This includes athletics on all levels, elementary, middle school, high school (varsity) and club level. Eventually, the RAP will have 25 athletic programs allowing for maximum participation.

Why is the Regional Athletic Program Important FNE?

Along with providing students world class academic opportunities, it is equally important to provide student athletes with world class sports. It will help set the standard of excellence that we expect from our students on every level. It will attract top notch colleges to the FNE when recruiting talent in Colorado.

When is the Regional Athletic Program going start?

Meetings have started and the committee is going to begin interviewing candidates that will diagnose and organize the many different programs already established in the FNE. The targeted date is to begin programs for all ages by the fall of 2011.

Who will be able to participate in the Regional Athletic Program?

All students who live in the Montbello/GVR area will be able to participate. The program will be setup to start student/athletes with the fundamentals in little league and then moving up into a highly competitive varsity program with the top student/athletes from the area. Any student from any school in the area will have the opportunity participate.

What if my student/athlete is good does not make varsity and still wants to participate?

There will always be an opportunity for your student/athlete to play in the RAP program. Club level sports, similar to college level intramurals, will participate in competitive league play. The way this league is going to be designed will also give student/athletes exposure to college scouts.

Where will the games be played?

Fortunately the FNE has many regulation fields and courts. The new Evie Dennis Campus will be the home to many varsity athletics home games. However, we will use all of the facilities we have in the FNE to give all students an opportunity to showcase their athletic abilities

How can I be involved with the RAP?

There will be many coaching opportunities and we will be looking for certified and trained coaches for 25 different programs on 4 different levels.

How will transportation be provided to students from all schools to participate?

With the proposed shuttle system, and the coordination of times with all schools in the area, student/athletes will have the opportunity to participate by getting on a bus that will take them to the game or practice site.
